This Honors Internship and accompanying Academic Scholarship will be granted by CFFC to a member of the senior class who has been actively involved in community service, emphasizing the protection and preservation of natural, agricultural and/or historic resources within the school environment or within the county generally. During the year, the recipient will be given the opportunity to participate in CFFC projects and work as an intern with conservation and planning professionals. The student will also be invited to attend one or more of the organization's monthly Board of Directors' meetings. The related scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000. The winner will be announced at the beginning of the year and the funds will be awarded at the end of the student's Senior year internship, prior to college.

Two Intern Scholarships will be granted. Students will be selected from among the senior classes of Fauquier County Public Schools. This application and all accompanying materials must be returned to the respective high school Career Center **not later than Noon on September 30, 2010**.
