- 1 Remington's rich history and revitalization efforts are facing the greatest challenges yet with the surge of data center developments that threaten the character, charm and potential of the town.
- 2 The four data centers in Remington, all with multiple buildings up to 80 feet tall, will consume more than 600 acres of land in the service district - equivalent to 478 football fields, and could lead to more power lines
- 3 Approximately 600 Remington residents live within half a mile of one of the four data centers and will have to deal with noise, pollution and mammoth buildings that are impossible to ignore.
- 4 Multiple data centers in Remington are NOT inevitable. Residents need to carefully evaluate all the information available in deciding the town's future and recognize that data center developers who stand to make huge sums of money may not have the town's best interest in mind.
- 5 The key to preventing Remington from becoming a data center hub and precluding more desirable development possibilities is to say no to rezonings.
